6th Semester Examination (UG Programmes)- 2019-20

Pursuant to the guide lines issued by MHRD, MHA, UGC and Govt. of the union territory of Jammu and Kashmir regarding the conduct of the examination of the students of B.A, B.Sc. B.Com. BCA semester 6 (Regular/ Private CBCS) of the academic session 2019-20, the following procedure shall be adopted for the same.

1. The terminal semester (6th Semester) end examination shall be conducted in the campus itself (As any other examination was used to be conducted Prior to Covid-19 Pandemic),
2. Details about the mode of examination in theory courses are given in A, B & C tables below.

Note:-

- a) A student shall have to attempt only 50 questions in courses having maximum weightage of 100 marks. In case the number of questions attempted by a student are more than 50, the first 50 questions attempted by the candidate shall only be evaluated.
- b) A student shall have to attempt only 25 questions in courses having maximum Weightage of 50 marks. In case the number of questions attempted by a candidate are more than 25, the first 25 questions attempted by candidate shall only be evaluated.
- c) Mathematics paper shall be of 2 hours duration.

Note:

- a) A student shall have to attempt only 40 MC questions in papers having maximum Weightage of 80 marks. In case the number of questions attempted by a student are more than 50, the first 50 questions attempted by the candidate shall only be evaluated

- b) A student shall have to attempt only 20 MC questions in papers having maximum weightage of 40 marks. In case the number of questions attempted by a candidate are more than 20, the first 20 questions attempted by candidate shall only be evaluated.
- c) Both objective and descriptive type examinations shall be conducted on the same day and in the same session (sitting) . Total time allotted collectively for both papers is 120 minutes (2 hours) only.
- d) 50% choice shall be given to the students for selecting questions from the question paper framed from the component of the curriculum earmarked for descriptive questions.


