Pursuant to the to the UGC guide lines for the conduct of examinations/promotions of the students of UG programmes for the session 2019-20 and in anticipation of the approval by the academic council of the college, the following information is notified for the students of B.A, B.Sc.& B.Com programmes (Sem.2nd & 4th Regular- CBCS Pattern) of the academic session 2019-20.

1. Students of Sem. 2nd & 4th. shall be evaluated for each course out of a maximum of marks indicated as under

Nature of the Course	Maximum marks	a) 50% Weightage for previous performance (Marks)	b). 50% Weightage for Internal Assessment (Marks)
Science Theory	100	50	50
Science Practical/Practical	50	25	25
Arts Courses	100	50	50
Communication Languages	50	25	25
Environmental sciences(EVS)	50	25	25
Skill Courses	100	50	50

- a) 50% weightage shall be for the performance of a student in the external examination of the same subject of the previous semester i.e. Sem.1st / 3rd as the case may be.
- b) 50% weightage shall be for the Internal Assessment which shall be subdivided as under
 - I). 60% of internal assessment marks shall be for the Assignments
 - II). 40% of internal assessment marks have been equally bifurcated into:-
 - a) Marks for attendance (pre and Post Covid-19 Pandemic)
 - b) Marks for performance in viva-voce to be conducted through any suitable online mode.

However, the same procedure shall be applied to the re-appear/ backlog candidates as and when they clear the backlogs.

This is a onetime modification in scheme of the computation of the results, necessitated due to the disruptions caused by Covid-19 Pandemic and shall not to be claimed as a right in future.
