

At the mushroom cultivation unit, three types of mushrooms viz. button mushroom (Agaricus bisporus), Oyster mushroom (Dhingri) (Pleurotus sp.) and milky white mushroom (Calocybe indica) are being cultivated. Student got familiar with Spawn production, substrate preparation,
