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



Report of "NAAC Awareness Workshop (Jammu Division)" held on 13/7/2021

Background:

Vide Govt. order No. : 225- JK(HE) 2021, Dated :-07-07-2021 a committee was constituted to expedite the process of compilation of the data for self assessment and thereafter accreditation by the NAAC. Pursuant to the constitution of this committee, a plan for implementation of the focal issues as envisaged in the terms of references was worked out. Thereafter a schedule of NAAC Awareness Workshops was issued.

Consequent to the issuance of the schedule of the workshops, Principal, Govt. College for Women Parade Ground, Jammu, organized a day long NAAC awareness workshop on 13/7/2021. Principals of eight different Colleges of Jammu province assigned to this College, along with the IQAC coordinators of their respective institutions were invited to attend the workshop which was organized on Cisco Webex online platform. Among others, Dr. Ravinder Tickoo, Nodal principal, G.G.M Science College, Jammu also participated in the workshop.

The workshop was organized in three consecutive sessions:-

- Introductory session
- Presentation session
- Interaction session



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a) **Introductory Session:-** All Principals briefly introduced themselves and the IQAC coordinators of their respective institutions. The College Principals also made a brief introduction of the status of their respective institutions in terms of availability of infrastructure, faculty position, and student enrolment status, diversity of the programmes offered, institutional distinctiveness, potential and constraints. 

- 3) BMC, rural, urban local bodies, even local body (Municipal and Panchayat) shall constitute a biodiversity management committee with in its area for the purpose of promoting conservation, sustainable use and documentation of biological diversity including preservation of habitats, conservation of land , races, folk varieties, cultivars, domesticated stocks and breeds of animals and microorganism. The documentation of Biodiversity thus prepared shall be called **People's Bio-Diversity**.

4. He further emphasized that for all this we need to interact people at grass root level as they are the real caretakers of the biodiversity and their surroundings and different committees have been formed up to Panchayat level. He encouraged that everyone, young or old and particularly students should participate in the process with full enthusiasm.

Between

Govt. College for Women between parade ground, Jammu through its Principal hereafter to as G.C.W Parade Jammu (which term shall so far as the context admits deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the first part.

Buddha Art and Painting located at Lower Shiv Nagar, Jammu, J&K - 180001 through Smt. Sanjogita Dogra.

And whereas the Govt. College for Women Parade ground, Jammu has decided to associate the home science and allied departments with the activities of Buddha Art and Crafts Studio, Jammu in order to have Art and Craft incubation cell for giving hands on experience to students.

Now therefore, it is hereby agreed between the Parties as follow:-

1. Govt. College for Women, Parade Ground, Jammu responsibilities.
- 1.1 Shall provide sharing of resource like infrastructure, faculty Material for Art and Craft.
- 1.2 Shall provide the students as human resource to cooperate and coordinate with the activities of Buddha Art and Craft Studio for giving knowledge and skill to the students in the Area of Art and Crafts and Painting.
2. Buddha Art and Craft Studio Jammu shall provide its resource required in the learning process and skill development for the students of GCW Parade ground, Jammu.

- 2.1 Buddha Art and Craft Studio Jammu shall hold practicals with the help of experienced faculty, the faculty will be provided by Budh Art and Craft and will not claim the Salary from the College (GCW).
- 2.2 Buddha Art and Craft Studio Jammu shall design Training programmes for the students of G.C.W Parade ground Jammu for enhancement of skill in Art and Craft, which will help the students to be future entrepreneur.
- 2.3 The Buddha Art and Craft Studio Jammu shall organize Exhibitions cum sale in Joint Venture with GCW Parade. The 30% profit will be divided among the Students, College and Buddha.

Force Majeure

Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of it obligation under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of the force Majeour conditions and provided that the party claiming force Majeour shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfill and continue performance hereunder with almost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause are removed.

Any extraordinary event which cannot be controlled by the parties shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a force Majeour event. Such events include acts of God. Acts or omissions at any government or Agency there of compliance with rules, regulation or order of any government Authority, provide however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions in delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU. Such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disabled the performance of obligation as aforesaid.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction The assignment shall be governed by the Laws of India and the parties to this MOU hereby agree that the Courts at Jammu (J&K) shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any disputes or

further agree that no other Courts shall have jurisdiction to decided any dispute between the parties arising out of this Agreement.

In case the parties to this MOU commits any breach of the Terms and Conditions of this MOU or any violates any Stator provision or any government or statutory guidelines or any guidelines issued by the controlling Authority then. In addition to any other remedy as per law the other parties shall have no right to terminate this Agreement by serving at least 15 days written notice to the other parties. However on such termination all the parties shall continue to be liable to each other for completion of their mutual rights and obligations under this MOU which were there on the date of the termination of this Agreement.

It will hold Certificate and Diploma Courses in Art and Craft regularly for the students. 30% of the profit will be given to the Students and remaining 70% will be shared equally by the College and the Buddha Art Studio.
