



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
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One day Workshop on Various ICT Tools and Skills





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A Brief Report of 5 Day National Webinar on "Development Of E-Content Avoiding Plagiarism" Organized By IQAC, Govt.College For Women, Parade Ground, Jammu (An Autonomous College) from 24° -28° June,2020

WEBINAR DAY I (24.06.2020)

Under the negis of IQAC cell, Govt. College for Women, Parade Ground, Jammu, organized a five day national webinar, faculty development Program on "Development of e-content avoiding Plagiarism" from 24 th to 28 th June, 2020. Around 218 participants from across the country and abroad registered for the webinar. On 24° June, the webinar link was provided to the participants and more than 182 participants logged in from their respective ends. At 11.30am, Dr Preeti Dubey organizing secretary of webinar, greeted all with a warm welcome and oriented the participants towards the content and conduct of the webinar on the selected digital platform, "Gotomeetings". Thereafter, she handed over the forum to Mr.S.K.Dhar, Convenor, IQAC for the introductory speech. He extended a warm welcome to Dr S. P Saraswat, Principal of theCollege and chief patron, esteemed resource person for the day Dr Ashok Sharma, Associate Professor, School of Computer Engineering, Lovely Professional University, Punjab and theparticipants. He highlighted the need for adoption of "neo-normals" in teaching and learning as a response to the testing times caused by COVID-19 pandemic.

-This was followed by the welcome address by Dr S.P. Saraswat, principal of college. Dr S. P. Saraswat extended his greetings to the participants and expressed his pleasure at the overwhelming response that the webinar received from the participants. He introduced Dr Ashok Sharma, the resource person of the day to the participants and appreciated his valued presence.

He also apprised the participants of the other resource persons and domain experts who would be joining the webinar in the subsequent days. Further, he spoke about the ethical aspects pertaining to plagiatism which the faculty should get acquainted with and sensitized to while uploading e-content respectively.

The technical session was then taken over by Dr Ashok Sharma who discussed at length the introduction to e-content development tools. His presentation revolved around the subtopies such as creating site in MoodleCloud, designing the site, adding the courses in site, adding contents like sudio/video/PPT etc., adding participants, giving permission to participants, adding examination in site, creating MCQ/short answer/quizzes, conducting online task, evaluating the task and uploading marks and data analytics in assessment and finally concluded his session on

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'Blakboard' as a widely used Learning Management Software. He interacted with the participants and cleared their doubts. WEBINAR DAY 2 (25.06.2020)

On day 2 of the webinar, 170 participants joined from their respective ends. The webinar started with warm greetings to the participants by Dr Preet iDubey. She introduced the resource person of the session, Dr. Vishal Goel, Professor, Department of Computer Science Punjabi University Patiata and coordinator, Research Centre for Technology Development for Differently Abled Persons. He is also coordinator Artificial Intelligence and Data Science Centre. With huge research experience, his publications can be found in national and international journals of high repute. He also has four patients to his credit which include Hindi to Punjabi Machine Translation System, Punjabi to English Transliteration System. He is also the recipient of Young Scientist award 2005 at 8 th Punjab Science Congress at Punjab Science Academy, Punjabi University, Patiala, National Merit Scholarship Award by Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, Certificate of appreciation by JETWI, Honorary Membership by North America Punjabi University Alumni Association, North America, only to name a few.

Dr Goel delivered his talk on the areas of plagiarism and Plagiarism Detection Tools, NMEICT-Initiative by MHRD, Govt. of India, Flipped Classrooms, ICT initiatives by Punjabi University Patiala during COVID-19 Lockdown. During the course of his presentation, he also talked about popular plagiarism detection tools like-Urkund. Turnitin, Ithenticate, and other online free plagiarism detection tools and Indian designed plagiarism detection tools. He also elaborated on the effectiveness of flipped classroom at such times of crisis.

He also spoke about National Mission on Education Through ICT (NMEICT) an initiative of Ministry of Human Resources Development, Govt. of India. The presentation was followed by an interactive session wherein the participants could gain clarity on the subjects presented.

WEBINAR DAY 3 (26.06.2020)

On day 3 of the webinar, 3 resource persons were invited for the presentations. Dr. Preeti Dubey introduced Mr. Amitavo Mitra, Ms. Garinta Sahney and Ms. Vancesha Jain, Associate Partners of Sai Krishna and Associates, Noida. Mr. Amitavo Mitra has an extensive experience and expertise in patent drafting and prosecution, particularly in the domain of bio-technology, pharmaceuticals, bio-medical engineering and the FMCG sector. Ms. Garinta Sahney, leads the patent prosecution and analytics practice of the firm and plays a pivotal role in patent litigation matters as well. She is a registered patent agent and a patent attorney in India. Whereas, Ms. Vancesha Jain has worked on policy matters, with a specialization in technology, copyright and data protection. She has acted as one of the advisors to the Government of India's department for promotion of

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industry and internal trade at the Ministry of Trade and Commerce on several matters related to Intellectual Property Rights.

The first technical session began with Mr.Amitavo's presentation on Intellectual Property Rights. He introduced participants to different forms of IPRs such as Copyrights, Patent, Plant variety, Geographical Indication, Trademark, Trade Secret and Industrial Design. He spoke about the importance of IPR as it protects the creative input of a person and provides legal status of ownership to the creator. He also stressed upon the need of IPR in academic settings. He apprised the participants of the acts pertaining to protection of IPR, associated procedure for filing of patents as it exists in India and abroad. The response to the interactive session he had undertaken was overwhelming.

Thereafter, Ms. Vancesha Jain presented a session on introduction to copyright laws. In her detailed presentation, she talked about registration process pertaining to copyright, copyright act 1957, various sections under (C.R.) Act, nature and objectives of this act, and when, how and in which type of works Copyrights can be claimed. She explained the difference between assignment of Copyright under section 18 and 19, and licensing of Copyright under section 30. She concluded her presentation by throwing light on the application process for registering for Copyright. The participants exuded enthusiasm during the interactive session that followed soon after.

The third resource person, Ms.Garima Sahney, being a leading patent prosecutor, through interactions, dealt with the queries of participants to their utmost satisfaction.

WEBINAR DAY 4 (27.06.2020)

On day 4 of the webinar, Dr. Preeti Dubey welcomed the participants and introduced Dr. Ramesh C. Sharma, an eminent educationist with a global exposure and is an expert in open and distance and technology mediated learning.. Dr Ramesh Sharma teaches Instructional Design at Ambedkar University Delhi, India. Earlier he has taught Educational Technology and Learning Resources at Wawasan Open University, Malaysia. He is an expert in open and distance and technology mediated learning and has served as a visiting Professor at Universidade do Estado da Bahia, UNEB, Salvador, Bahia, Brazil, visiting Professor at University of Fiji, Fiji, Commonwealth of Learning as Director of the Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia, New Delhi, Regional Director of Indira Gandhi National Open University, India and Director of Distance Education at University of Guyana, Guyana, South America. He had been a member of Advisory Group on Human Resources Development for the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). While at University of Guyana he also collaborated with UNDP for its Enhanced Public Trust, Security and Inclusion (EPTSI) project, Volunteer Service Overseas (VSO) and United Nations Volunteer (UNV) to develop suitable educational opportunities for communities and youth. He is editing Asian Journal of Distance Education since 2003 and has been associated with several other peer reviewed journals including SSCI / SCOPUS Journals as Reviewer, Editor and Editorial Advisory Board member in the field of Open and Distance Learning. An author/editor of several books and research papers on educational technology, educational multimedia and eLearning, Dr. Sharma is a



practitioner promoting Open Educational Resources (OER). He has been a trainer and capacity builder in the field of educational technology, and has supervised doctoral research in the field. He has conducted workshops and evaluation activities for IGNOU, CEMCA, COL, UNCTAD, and Aga Khan Foundation, amongst others.

Dr.Ramesh C Sharma spoke at length on Plagiarism, why do people plagiarise, difference between plagiarism and copyright infringement. He also talked about the various types of plagiarism and discussed case studies wherein plagiarism cost dearly to the doer. He also touched upon international policies on research integrities. He also made participants aware of the benefits of introducing COPE(Committee on Publication Ethics) in colleges to check plagiarism. He also stressed upon using social bookmarking sites for one's research work. He provided the participants names of websites offering free open education resources for development of e-content and other purposes.

WEBINAR DAY 5 (28.66.2020)

On day 5 of the webinar, Dr. Preeti Dubey welcomed the participants and introduced Mr. Pritam Juvatkar as a resource person for the second session who would be imparting hands-on training on Youtube video creation.

Dr. Preeti Dubey, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Applications, Government College for Women, Parade Ground, Jammu conducted the first session wherein she talked about online assessment.

This was followed by the second session by Mr.Pritam Juvatkar, the resource person for the day. Jammu chapter. In his address he said that the prevailing social and





REPORT

ONE- DAY WORKSHOP ON START UPS AND INCUBATION

Govt. College for Women Parade Ground Jammu, organized one day workshop on "Startup and Incubation" In collaboration with KPMG(A professional service company and one of the big four auditors), on 23rd April 2019, under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC) of college, in which students and faculty from different colleges of the city participated. The aim of this workshop was to motivate and inspire the young students to become self reliant using their innovative skills.

On the occasion, the Chief Guest, the commissioner secretary, Higher Education, Talat Parvez Rohella presented his reviews regarding Startups and termed it as 'need of the hour'. He spoke about the opportunities available in the National/International market and urged that the workshop be taken to the next higher level to make headway in translating brilliant ideas into Startups at micro, mini and mega levels. He also made the youth aware of the scope of Startups in J & K in the areas of Agriculture, Sericulture, Floriculture, Livestock and Fisheries, Horticulture and Tourism. He also highlighted the emerging trends in the market-from mechanization to digitization and stressed on the need for development of linguistic skills to complement innovative ideas.

The session began with welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Hemla Aggarwal, Principal of College. She emphasized on the need for Startup ventures and Entrepreneurship programmes to run along with the regular curriculum in educational institutions for strengthening the youth to face economic challenges of the coming times.

In the second session, Dr. Sheikh Fayaz, JKEOI interacted with the students and faculty of different colleges. He spoke about the dependence of modernization and economical and technological inequalities on two factors- Geographical Luck and Pro- innovative culture of a country. He emphasized on the enhancement of critical and innovative thinking and conversion of knowledge into action through the mantra of 4C- Critical thinking, Creativity, Collaboration and Communication.

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REPORT ON 3- DAY WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

3- day workshop on research methodology was organized by Govt. College for Women, Parade Ground Jamuna, an Aktonomous college with CPE status by DGC, from 30th January 2018 to 1th February 2018. Workshop was inaugurated by Chief Goest, Dr. Asagar Hassan Samoon, Principal Secretary to Govi Higher Education, J&K. Guest, of Honour, Dr. Zahoor Ahmed Chatt, Director Colleges, Higher Education, J&K was also present on the occusion. Welcome address was given by Dr. Hemla Aggarwal. Principal of the college. She said that Dr. Samoon, a revered personality has always shown great interest in research activities & encourage teaching faculty of college to involve in research activities which will give them insight to plan their lectures in a better way for the students. She also stressed upon the significance of Research in today's education system as it helps teachers to develop the requisite knowledge and skills to become affective classroom leaders capable of implementing the national reforming Higher education by developing scientific temperament in teachers as well as in students. Dr. Samoon, Principal Secretary too in his address stressed upon the teaching faculty to work hard and evolve a smart work culture for the betterment of student community.

The first session began with the tecture of Prof. Reichn Tanteur, Former Director, Women studies Research Centre, University of Kuruksherra. She spoke on "Ferninist Research Methodology". She said that Feminist Research is exclusively concerned about various issues and challenges that the women are facing in male stream world. The objective of such research is to bring a catalystic change in society that would lead all of us to a new world of Gender equality. She also stressed upon the need to Reject Traditional Research methods based on assumptions of powerful mainstream at the expense of Women's dignity and recognition. The need of hour is to recommunic domain of convenient research, where we see gender in new context with aim for positive soons change. She compiled her Lecture briefing the participants about methods one should follow while doing research, such as, maintaining diaries, strong will power, consistency in work, study of History (Review of literature), infield work identification and understanding of facts in depth, to be unbiased; to set ideology, use tape record & camera etc.

Second Session started with the Lecture of Dr. Supran Kumar Sharma, Associate Professor, School Of Business, SMVDU, who spoke on the topic " Why Should I care About Research"? He told participants that everyone should involve in research if they have opted teaching as their profession because it will help them to keep themselves abreast with the contemporary world and keep their mental ability sharp. He advised the participants to be very wise in selecting their topic which should preferably be based on broad area. One should be very sincere while reviewing the literature because it consists of

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critical reading, evaluating and organising existing literature on the topic to assess the state of knowledge in the area. He also told research is not just about the collection of data though data collection is important, but it is simply part of a wider process — the research process. He further discussed 8 steps followed in research process which included selection of topic, reviewing the literature, developing your theoretical and conceptual frameworks, clarifying your research question, developing a research design, collecting data, analysing data, and drawing conclusions. He concluded his facture by telling participants to relate their work to the research process which will allow them to develop & answer your research questions in a logical & systematic manner.

Third session of the day began with the fecture by Prof. Pemela Shingla, Department of Social work, Delhi University. She deliberated on the topic "Ethics & Management of Research". She started her secture by giving some effective tips to the participants about how one should manage their research. She said two types of communication were significant to manage a good research - a. Communication between a scholar & guide, b. Communication with the people in the field which can help the scholar to collect data. For research, patience, will power, determination, consistency is a must for scholar to make research easy scholar should learn to manage papers rooster, files & fee slips till they face their vivaversa. She also inform the participants that the Ideal thesis consist of 252 to 300 pages, inclusive of Title cover, Index, Chapters, Page of Abbreviations used and Bibliography. She told them never to overlap their contents which will make their thesis sub stranded. One should also avoid too much of review of literature in methodology. She personally felt that every chapter should talk about 4-5 objectives it would discussed and the research should be objective centric. One should extensively use an operational definition in research study and should frame spontaneous questionnaires to create a story of data. For field work she advised that the research scholar should know well the local dialectic of the area where he/she has gone for collection of data. They should show keen interest in the lives of people on which their research project is and engage them in discussion to fetch information. For effective communication and true findings one should understand the experiences of target groups and this is only possible if you listen them and understand the challenges they face. These methods will surely not only make their research casy but even more commendable.

First session of the second day of workshop began with the lecture of Prof. Nilofer Khan, from Kashmir University who spoke on "Primary/Secondary data collection (Tools & Techniques)". She said that the task of data collection begins after a research problem has been defined and research design /plan chalked out. She defined Primary data as those which are collected a fresh and for the first time and thus happen to be original in character whoreas. Secondary Data have been collected by someone also and have already been passed through the statistical process. There are several tools & techniques with which

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PRINCIPAL Gest. College for Women Parada Ground, James a scholar can collect primary data with help of Surveys, questionnaires, interviews etc. with the respondent, reading of novels in case of literature or observations and direct communications with respondent. Whereas the method of collecting secondary data was easy as they have already been collected and analyzed by someone clse. It may either be published or unpublished data. Researcher must be very careful in using secondary data, because the data available may sometimes be unsuitable. She also deliberated on advantages & disadvantages of research methodology of field work. She informed the participants about various observations one can be involved with while carrying out research.

The second session on 31" fanuary started with the locture of Dr. Rajinder Preshin, Associate professor, Extension Education SKAUST. The topic of his fecture was "Research Design". He started his locture by talking about the goals of research which are exploratory, descriptive & explanatory in nature. Exploratory goal deals with how & why questions. This first step makes scholar familiar with the basic sets and concerns about the work of research. It further creates a general mental picture of conditions generate new ideas, conjectures, or hypothesis & determine the feasibility of conducting research, develop techniques for measuring and locating future data. Descriptive research goal provides a detailed, highly accurate picture of the research area. It locates new data that contradicts past data. He said that the descriptive research aims at making of a report on the context of a situation whereas explanatory goal of research deals with the questions, tests the predictions, elaborates observations, enriches a theory by explaining it logically. He concluded by saying that Basic Research is a fundamental knowledge about the social world. It focuses on refuting or supporting theories that explain how the social world operates. It is the source of most new scientific ideas and ways of thinking about the world. On the other hand Applied Research is used to solve specific problems or help practitioners to accomplish tasks.

Post session lunch on second day started with the lecture of lvir. Arvind Kumar, Assistant Professor, Dr. K.R. Narayanan, Centre for Dalit and Minorities Studied famile Millia, Delhi, His discussion was on the topic reliability & validity of measurement and data. He started his locture with the Traditional historians who held that there could be no history without an archive. But it is difficult to write a history of prejudice where the evidence that Identifies or signifies its everyday forms and discriminatory behavior is scroppy and ambiguous. Studies have shown that 'Bioradari is undisputedly present in Muslim society across India, though Islam does not profess ensie, race & class. He concluded his locture by saying that in Delhi these Biradaries in Muslim communities were set based on ideological strata rather than Islam which really needs to be changed.

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Fourth session of the day started with the lecture on research methodology in science by Prof. S.K. Khosa, from Central University, Januaru. He defined research as means to find answers to the questions. Through research, new and original information about the world we live in, are obtained. Research is scientific and systematic search for truth about specific topic. Reviewing literature is important to understand to understand how others have approached or dealt with the problem. Researcher should collect data in an organized and controlled manner so as to arrive at valid decisions by analyzing data to the problem sop that one could reach to appropriate conclusion. Proper planning is required to design research program and it should be highly ethical in its standards. He also informed participants about research methodology in science for e.g. adequate marks for decision that a researcher needs, he should be clear with the findings he should have a justified conclusion and last but not the least his experience should be reflected in his dissertation.

The first session on the last day of the workshop, I* February 2018, started with a lecture on "preparing of proposals" by Prof. Lokesh Verma, from Central University, Jammu. He said research proposal is generally divided in to two sections - (A) introductory section (B) Method section. In the introductory Section, he discussed the different aspects of research i.e. Title of the research proposal, Statement of the problem, Review of related literature, Area of research, Objectives of research study, Hypothoses or questions underlying the study. Significance of study, Delimitations of the area under study. In Method Section he discussed about various aspects of methods involved in research such as Population and sample, Tools, Research Method, Analytical Procedure, Time Schedule, Budget and References.

Prof. Munish Sharma from SKAUST was the resource person for the second session after the ten break. He made the participants familiar with the analysis & parametric/non-parametric data by SPSS. He also talked about detailed framing of Hypothesis & different statistical test to be applied for testing the significance & co-zelation of variables.

Last session was conducted by Prof. Vijay Shivgotra, Department of Statistics, University of Junimu. He talked about collection , representation , analysis and interpretation of data.

The chief guest of valedictory function was Director Colleges Dr. Zahoor Ahmed Chan, Dr. Geetanjali. A. Rane was the guest of honour. In this session a brief report of the workshop was presented feedback was taken from the participants and contificates were distributed to the participants by the chief guest.
