

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS/INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES:

1. Admissions shall be made on the basis of score/marks obtained in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET PG 2024) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
2. PROVISIONAL ADMISSION will be offered to the applicants, who have passed first 5 semesters of the qualifying Bachelors Degree Examination (Honours or General)/ 6 Semesters OR any other examination recognised as equivalent thereof, from a recognised university/institution with at least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) as on the date of admission.
3. **Notwithstanding anything contained in the statutes, a candidate who has appeared or is appearing in the final semester/ year of the qualifying examination and is expecting to pass with the requisite percentage of aggregate marks in the said examination and fulfils the program specific eligibility is eligible to apply.** However, the applicants provisionally admitted to the program shall have to submit the result of the final semester/ year of the qualifying examination **within 45 days** from the date of commencement of their class work.
4. Filling up of the Online Admission Form is a pre-requisite for admission. The candidates are required to fill the same carefully as per the statutes.
5. Candidates are advised to be in continuous touch with the college website/admission portal for the latest information with respect to admission, eligibility and other details.
6. Admission in any PG Course shall be subject to the condition that atleast one-third of the seats are filled. If the admission is less than one-third, the college reserves the right to suspend the admission in that particular course.

1.	SCQP09	Computer Science	Master of Computer Application(MCA)	A candidate seeking admission to MCA programme must have passed in the final year of BCA/ B.Sc (computer science) or equivalent examination (with at least 50% of the aggregate marks for general category and 45%for SC/ST category) and Mathematics as one of the subjects at 10+2 level. However, candidate who has not studied computer science subjects at UG level and/or has not passed mathematics paper at 10+2 level, is also eligible to apply.(Such candidates need to enroll and compulsorily pass the bridge course of four credits in addition to the passing regular Semester-1 courses during semester 1,in order to get eligible for admission to Semester 3 of MCA 2-years programme.
2.	LAQP01	English	Master of Arts(M.A.)	For admission to the programme, first preference will be given to the candidates who have passed BA(Honours) in English or with English Literature as the main, elective,or additional subject irrespective of whether the examination passed is in Arts, Science or Commerce stream for at least 4 semesters and with 50% of aggregate marks for General category 45% SC/ST Category. A candidate who has passed in the qualifying examination without English Literature subject may also be considered subject to the availability of the seats, provided she has scored a minimum of 60%marks in the qualifying examination.

3.	HUQP14	Music	Master of Arts (M.A.)	A candidate seeking admission must have passed bachelor degree in the stream of Music. The candidate with Music as an elective/additional subject at under graduate level or Honours in Music is also eligible. OR Graduation in any discipline (Arts,Commerce,Science) from UGC recognized university with the following Diploma course (06/07 years): Sangeet Visharad Purna, Sangeet Prabhakar from recognized following Music Boards of India:a)Akhil Bhartiya Gandharav Mahamandal,Miraj/Mumbai,Maharashtra b)Prayag Sangeet Samiti,Allahabad,Uttar Pradesh.
4.	SCQP28	Zoology	Master of Sciences	A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed in the final year of Bachelor degree Examination with Zoology as one of the core subjects in all the three years and with 50%of aggregate marks for General Category 45% SC/ST category.
5.	HUQP11	Home Science	Master of Sciences	A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed B.Sc./B.A. with Home Science as one of the subject with percentage of 50%.Second preference will be given to candidates passing B.A. and having Sociology or Psychology as one of the subject and securing 50% in aggregate in qualifying examination. Third preference will be given to the candidates who have passed B.A. Examination with 60% or more aggregate in qualifying examination.

- In case only one seat is available under category 10(a), 10(b) or category 11(a), 11(b) the same shall be filled on basis of comparative merit of all the candidates under these categories put together, as the case may be.
- For determining the number of seats under any reserved category, fraction of less than one half shall be ignored and fraction of one half and more shall be treated as one. The benefit of fraction shall be given to each category separately even if it means an overall marginal increase in seats in any course of study.
- In case any of the seat/s remain vacant in a reserved category (which are convertible) for want of eligible candidates, the same will be offered to the candidates of non-reserved i.e. open merit group.
- Selection of candidates against reserved seats shall be made on the basis of comparative merit in the respective categories, except achievement categories.
- For selection under Achievement category inter-se-merit shall be determined in accordance to the Statute----a)marks/points awarded to such a candidate for these activities, plus b) one fourth (1/4) of the percentage of the CUET Score (CUET-PG-24). The composite score thus calculated, shall form the basis of admission.
- To be a beneficiary of reservation, the candidate must be a permanent resident / domicile of J&K UT, except when applying under categories 10(a), 10(b) i.e. Sports/cultural and Literary activities and 11(a), 11(b), i.e. NCC/NSS/Bharat Scouts and Guides activities for which he/she must have passed the qualifying examination from University of Jammu or from any recognized university within the Jammu province.
- Castes/Groups falling under ST(i) 1.Bakarwal 2.Balti 3.Beda 4.Bot,Boto 5.Brokpka,Drokpka,Dard,Shin 6.Changpa,7.Garra 8.Gaddi 9.Gujjar 10.Mon 11.Purigpa 12.Sippi;(existing list as per constitution (J&K) Schedule Tribes Order,1989 and the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) order (Amendment) Act,1991
