




(07-11-2022)

The Board of studies meeting for Department of Biotechnology, Govt. College for Women, Parade Ground Jammu was conducted at Department of Biotechnology through offline mode on 7th Nov, 2022 at 11:00 am. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the syllabi of the Undergraduate Programme in Biotechnology for 1st and 2nd semesters of session 2022-2023 under NEP Guidelines. The syllabus of semester 1st and 2nd comprised of one Major and one Minor course of (04+02) credits each and one Multidisciplinary course of (03) credits to be taken in each semester.

1. The Syllabi of Major and Minor Course offered in Undergraduate Programme in Biotechnology for Sem Ist was discussed by the panel in the beginning. The course entitled "**Cell Biology and Genetics**" comprising of five units (4 credits) discussing the basics of cell biology and genetics was considered well framed. The practical part of two credits conferring basic hands-on training in cell biology and genetics was also considered appropriate. Later on, while discussing the syllabi of Major and Minor course offered "**General and Applied Microbiology**" for Sem 2nd slight changes in the pattern were suggested with incorporation of topic **Bacteria and its types** in unit -02 and the omission of **Algae** word in the beginning of unit-03. The course content and practical part was considered appropriate and well framed.
2. In the meeting, the syllabi of Multidisciplinary course "**Biotechnology and Allied Sciences**" to be offered in semesters I, II and III respectively was also discussed in the end. It comprised of four units attributing to history, scope of biotechnology and its different branches, role of environment, food, plants and animals in relation with biotechnology. In Unit-04 the topic **Transgenic plants and their importance** was incorporated. The teaching hours for unit-01 were decided to be kept as 09 hrs for the content to be taught and for the rest three units 12 hrs of teaching was attributed. In the books recommended section incorporation of more Indian authored reference books was suggested by the panel since the course is to be taken by arts stream students.
3. It is pertinent to mention here that all the suggestions said by the worthy members of the board of studies were incorporated while reframing the syllabi.

(26-09-2022)

The Board of studies meeting for Department of Biotechnology, Govt. College for women, Parade Ground Jammu was conducted at Department of Biotechnology through both offline and online mode. The venue for the offline meeting was Department of Biotechnology GCW, parade while the online meeting using cisco webexlink: (<https://meet143.webex.com/meet143/j.php?MTID=mebbcdf246635776fe04983093e5c205f>) was conducted from the venue mentioned, on **26th Sep, 2022 at 11:30 am**. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the syllabi of the 5th and 6th semesters for the session 2022-2023. The syllabus of semester 5th comprised of two Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses of (04+02) credits and one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) of (02+02) credits while for semester 6th the syllabi comprised of one DSE of (04+02) credits and one SEC of (02+02) credits.

1. The board discussed the syllabi of semester 5th comprising of (DSE-I) Plant Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering and suggested the deduction of topic from theory "Isolation of DNA and RNA from viruses, bacteria, plants and animals" due to its repetition in the practical part while for DSE-II (Biotechnology for human welfare) the introduction of few new practical's was accepted as a part of syllabi. In the SEC-III Intellectual Property Rights the new course constituted of theory and practical of 2 credits each was considered well framed and was approved.

2. In the meeting, the syllabi of semester 6th (DSC-III) Immunology and Animal Biotechnology course was discussed and it was suggested to incorporate the topic "B cell and T cell differentiation, activation and memory" to enrich the syllabi and to deduct the topic "Complement cascade: components of complement, function of complement, different activation pathways" due to its complexity at graduation level. In the SEC-IV Clinical Biochemistry course the theory and practical part incorporated were considered at par with the requirement of the course.

3. The board also discussed about the module-based skill courses Bioinformatics III and Bioinformatics IV being offered in Sem 5th and 6th respectively. The syllabi for each semester constituted two credits each for theory and practical. The members of the board of studies unanimously approved the skill enhancement courses in Bioinformatics being offered in Sem 5th and 6th respectively. It is pertinent to mention here that all the suggestions deliberated by the members of the board of studies were incorporated while reframing the syllabi.










MINUTES OF THE MEETING
