Anticipated Outcomes of the Activity:

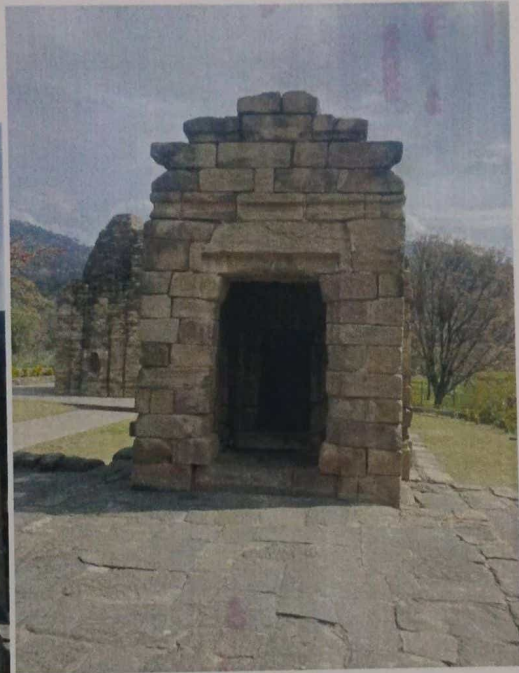
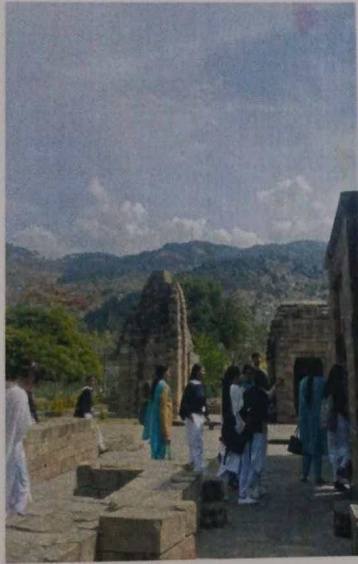
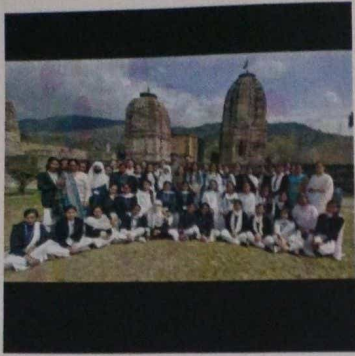
- The outcome of the visit is to create interest of the students in this field and also to understand about the various topics which we taught in their curriculum.

Report: Department of Anthropology, GCW Parade, Jammu went for One day visit to an Ancient Archaeological site at Kiramchi Temple, Udhampur. Kiramchi also known as Group of Temples is located at tehsil and district Udhampur. This temple consists of five temples dated back to eighth - ninth century CE. Out of five temples, three have been constructed on a common platform and the remaining two on a separate platform. Four temples face east and the smaller temple faces west. The four temples comprise of garbhagriha with curvilinear sikhara and an antarala with sukanasika.

- **Your Assessment on the realization of the anticipated outcomes:** This visit to an archaeological site at Kiramchi by the Department of Anthropology will enable the students not only to gain knowledge about the importance of sites for tracing the past but also create understanding about the ancient temples role in social, economic, and cultural fields. This visit also familiarize students with the processes and different methods of preservations of ancient sites.

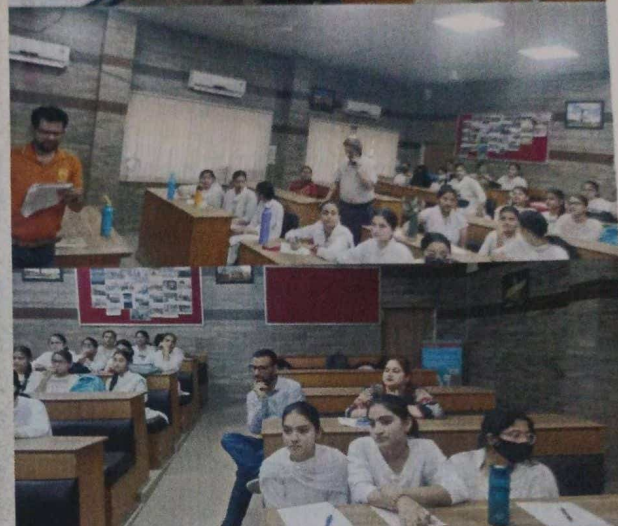
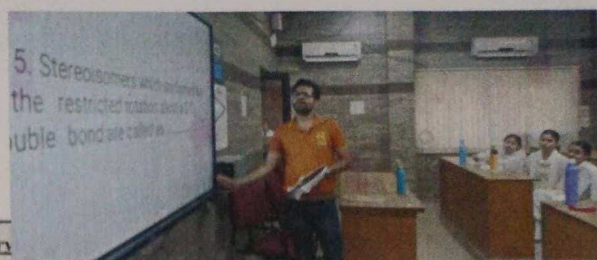

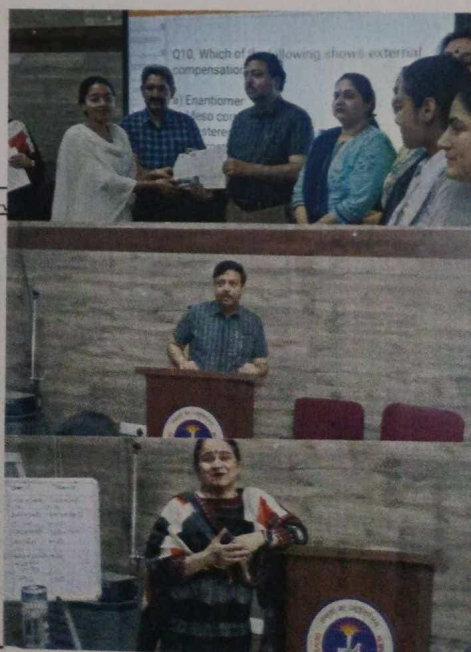
INTRODUCTION

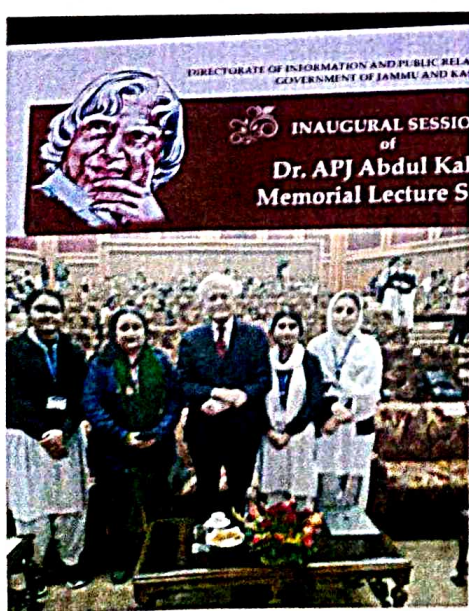
Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Azad Memorial Lecture Series Visit to Convention Centre

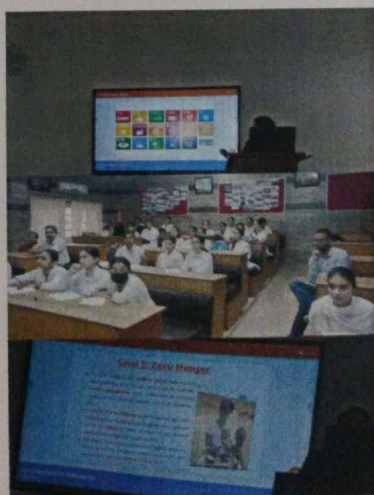
Workshop on Sustainable Development Goals

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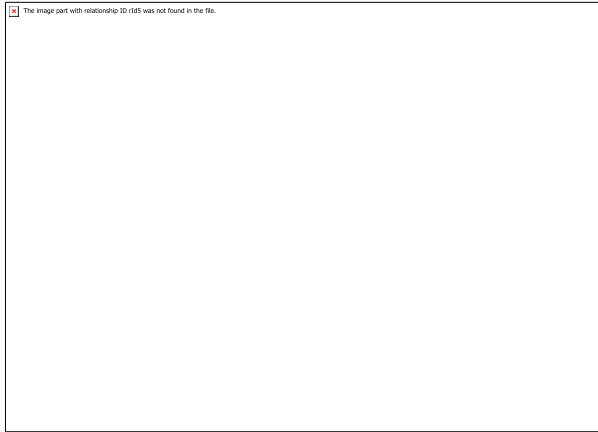

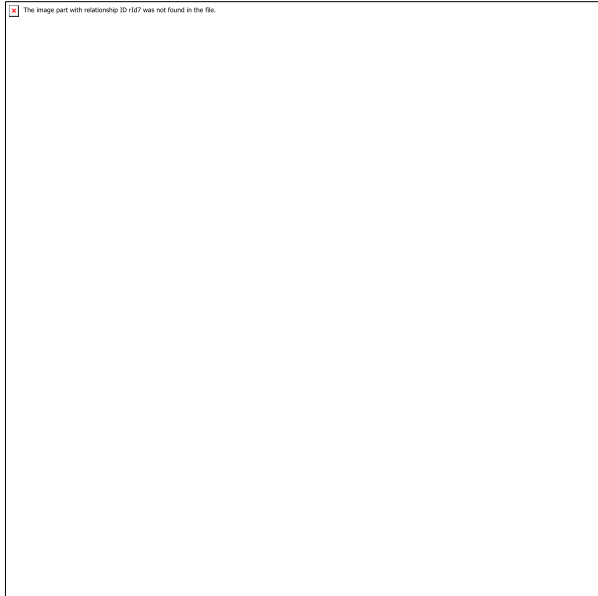
